Perry is co-sponsoring with Lenhartsville Fish & Game again this year to hold a youth trout fishing rodeo at their pond on Saturday, May 7th. The rodeo is open to members of both clubs, their children and grandchildren at the lower pond at Lenhartsville. You must have a fishing license and show your membership card to enter. Registration starts at 7:00 a.m. and fishing at 8:00 a.m. for kids 15 years of age or younger. Adults, 16 years of age and over, can fish after 12:00 p.m. up to 5:00 p.m. Prizes will be awarded. Bring your kids and fishing tackle for a day filled with fun. There is a three fish limit. Cost is \$5 for kids and \$10 for adults.



## **18th Annual Women On Target®**

Perry, along with the NRA Women-On-Target® program and NRA Foundation will again hold two 18th annual non-competitive, instructional clinics in recreational shooting and hunting sports this year on June 18th and September 10th.
