We are experiencing people using their car headlights and firing after sunset at the ranges. This is a violation of our regulations. We received complaints from neighbors and the township Supervisors. If caught, member violators will have their membership permanently revoked. Trespassers will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law. We are also experiencing shotgun firing at the steel pistol range. This is absolutely prohibited. Just a reminder that it is every members responsibility to patrol the ranges and assure that all shooters are following the range safety rules. Firearms must be pointed down range at all times. If someone is not a member or doesn't have a guest pass have them sign a guest pass under your name, collect the \$10 and drop same in the mail slot at the club house.
